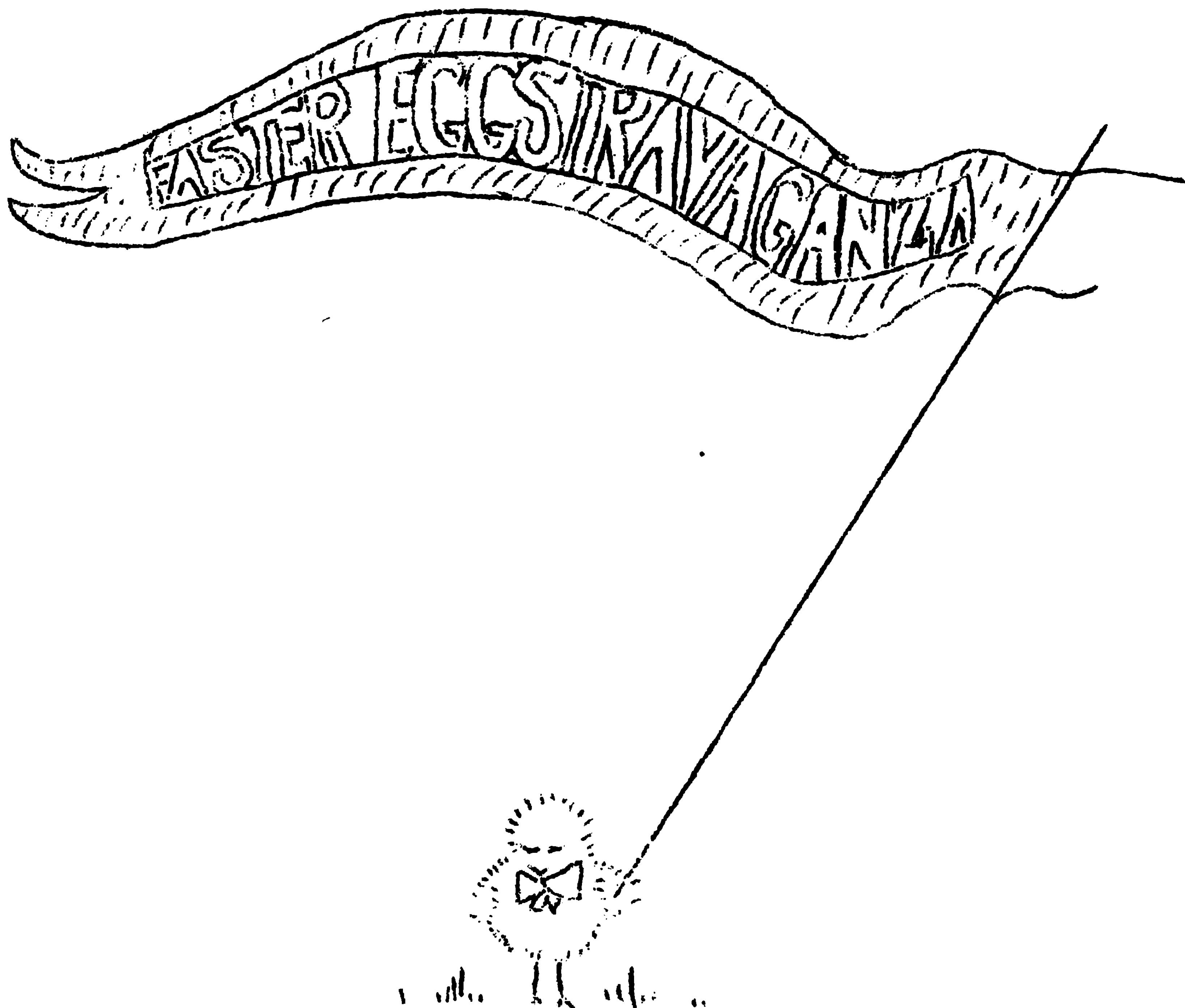

CIVIC THEATRE COOKRIDGE STREET LEEDS

In accordance with the requirements of
The West Yorkshire Metropolitan County Fire
Service:-
