



#### **Disabled Facilities**

Leeds Civic Theatre can accommodate approximately 20 wheelchairs, if booked well in advance. Please ring 462453 for full details.

The Leeds Civic Theatre shares the Institute Buildings with the Leeds College of Music. This may mean that occasionally performances may be subject to slight acoustic problems. Whilst both parties do everything within their power to keep this to a minimum, we cannot prevent it completely. We apologise, therefore, for any inconvenience which may be caused.

In accordance with the requirements of the Licensing Sub-Committee of Leeds City Council.

- (a) The public may leave at the end of the performance by all exit and entrance doors, and such doors must at that time be open.
- (b) All gangways, passages and staircases must be kept entirely free from chairs or any other obstruction.
- (c) Persons shall not be permitted to stand or sit in any of the intersecting gangways, or stand in any unseated space in the auditorium, unless standing in such a space as been specially allowed by the Licensing Committee. A notice is exhibited in that part of the auditorium in which standing has been sanctioned.
- (d) The satety curtain mast be lowered and raised once immediately before the commencement of each performance so as to ensure it being in proper working order.



#### THE AUTHOR AND THE PLAYS

Sir Terence Rattigan (1911–1977) was one of the most phenomenally successful dramatists of his era. Among his most famous successes were "French Without Tears" (1936), "The Winslow Boy" (1946), "Separate Table" (1954), "Bequest To The Nation" (1970), and "The Browning Version", which, together with "Harlequinade", won the Ellen Terry award for 1948. He was knighted in 1971 for services to the theatre. "Separate Tables" is really two plays in one, set in a Bournemouth hotel with a high proportion of permanent residents. The theme of this double bill is the isolation of its characters. Even though their lives are intertwined, they maintain a respectable social distance from one another until dramatic events shatter their veneer of peace and tranquillity and force them into a closer mutual understanding.

The Drama Group mounts five productions — usually including a musical or revue type show — at the Civic Theatre.


