







DIRECTORS NOTE

Charles Luteridge Dodgson (1832-98) an Oxford Mathematics lecturer, turned into Lewis Carroll to write this perenially charming story for his ten year old friend Alice Liddell. Beautifully adapted for the stage by Clemence Dane, it loses none of the freshness and subtlety of the book. Children today are as enchanted by it as they were a hundred years ago. The story is night-marish at times, but always entertaining and full of humour, where time is suspended and all is magic. I hope we succeed in taking you with us into dreamland.

For those of you, like me, who will be tormented by being unable to remember where the incidental music comes from, we have selections from—"Romeo and Juliet," "Love of Three Oranges" and "Lieutenant Kije," by Prokofiev, the clog dance from "La Fille mal Gardee," Harold Lanchberry Handel's music from the "Royal Fireworks," small extracts from Haydn and Bach, an Elizabethan tune "My Lady Carey's Dompe" and the opening music "Favre's Pavare."

I hope you, the audience, will enjoy watching my first play for the Arts Centre as much as I have enjoyed producing it.



Disabled Facilities

Leeds Civic Theatre can accommodate approximately 20 wheelchairs, if booked well in advance. Please ring 462453 for full details.

The Leeds Civic Theatre shares the Institute Buildings with the Leeds College of Music. This may mean that occasionally performances may be subject to slight acoustic problems. Whilst both parties do everything within their power to keep this to a minimum, we cannot prevent it completely. We apologise, therefore, for any inconvenience which may be caused.

In accordance with the requirements of the Licensing Sub-Committee of Leeds City Council.

- (a) The public may leave at the end of the performance by all exit and entrance doors, and such doors must at that time be open.
- (b) All gangways, passages and staircases must be kept entirely free from chairs or any other obstruction.
- (c) Persons shall not be permitted to stand or sit in any of the intersecting gangways, or stand in any unseated space in the auditorium, unless standing in such a space as has been specially allowed by the Licensing Committee. A notice is exhibited in that part of the auditorium in which standing has been sanctioned.
- (d) The safety curtain must be lowered and raised once immediately before the commencement of each performance so as to ensure it being in proper working order.
