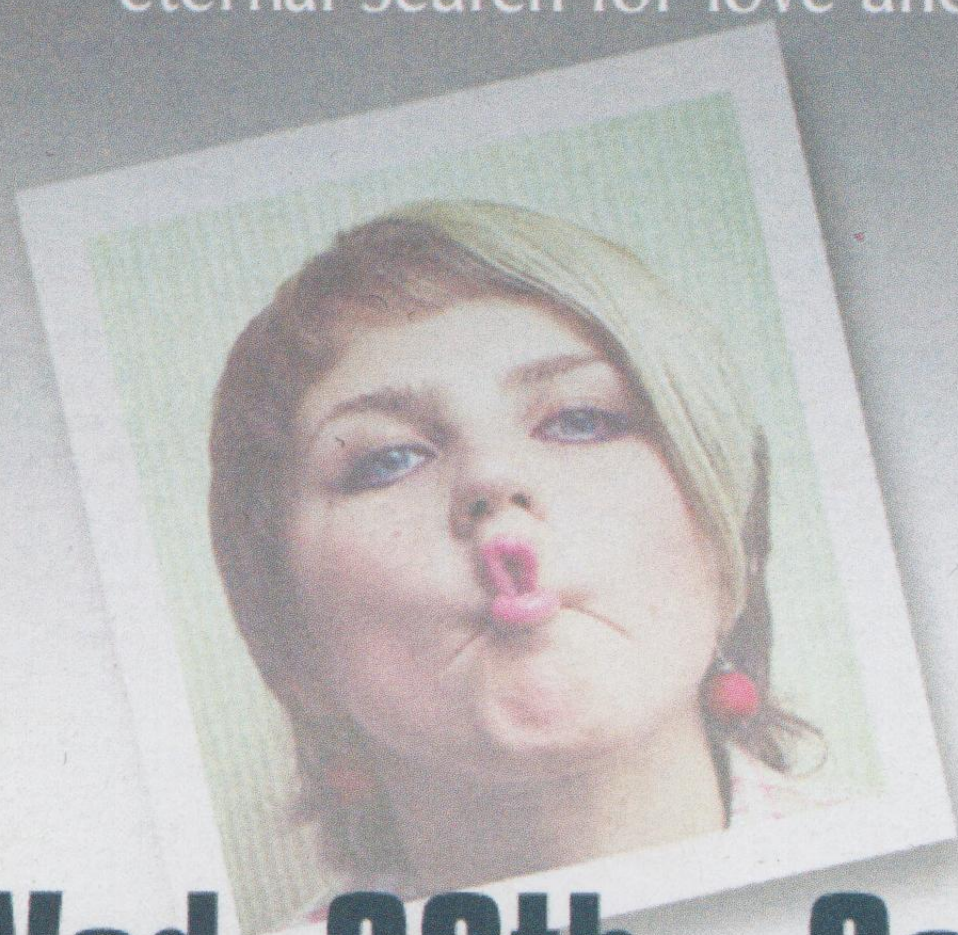
# Eddie & Crystal..
