The Moonstone



The Moonstone by Wilkie Collins was published in 1868. It was hugely popular and was described by T.S.Eliot as 'the first, the longest and the best of modern English detective novels'.

This 2011 stage adaptation by Robert Kauzlaric received excellent reviews, Time Out describing it as 'a ripping good tale'.

Rachel Verinder inherits a valuable Indian diamond, the Moonstone, from her uncle, a corrupt British army officer who stole it from a sacred temple. The diamond is of great religious significance and three Hindu priests have dedicated their lives to recovering it. Rachel wears the diamond at her 18th birthday party and later that night it is stolen from her bedroom. Unhappiness, misunderstandings and ill luck ensue. Who is the diamond thief, and will the precious Moonstone ever be found?
