About Leeds Arts Centre:

- LAC was formed in 1945 as an amateur society to encourage interest in the arts.
- LAC presents a varied programme of drama productions each year.
- LAC occasionally presents Green room activities for members only – these may be either social functions, or informal entertainments in rehearsal room settings to give members experience in acting, directing or backstage functions.
- LAC circulates a regular newsletter to keep members up to date with activities.
- LAC membership gives access to any joint activities with the Leeds Community Arts Network.

Extracts from the LAC and Leeds CAN Constitutions relating to membership:

- Persons desiring to become members of LAC shall submit their names in writing to the LAC Secretary on such form or forms as shall from time to time be devised by the LAC Committee.
- The LAC Committee shall have power at any time to refuse the admission of any person to membership.
- Members of LAC shall abide by all rules of LAC and of Leeds CAN, of the Carriageworks and where applicable of Leeds City Council.
- The Committee shall have the power to strike off the name of any member not complying with the LAC or Leeds CAN Constitutions, or doing anything detrimental to the interests of LAC.
- Leeds CAN conducts its business in a way that respects others. It is committed to equality of opportunity, and opposes all forms of discrimination against people because of their age, race, religion, culture, disability, ethnic/national origin, gender, sexual orientation or marital status.
- Leeds CAN expects its members, audiences and any other of its stakeholders to be treated with courtesy and respect. Verbal abuse, bullying, harassment and violence are unacceptable.
- Once recruited to an LAC show, members must adhere to agreed schedules and directions to ensure the highest possible standard of production. Members failing to do so save for unavoidable emergency or by negotiation may have their membership terminated.
- Members of LAC have personal responsibility to make themselves aware of LAC information, requests and recruitment by reference to the monthly newsletter.
- All members of LAC are expected to do a front of house or backstage job at least once during the year if required.
